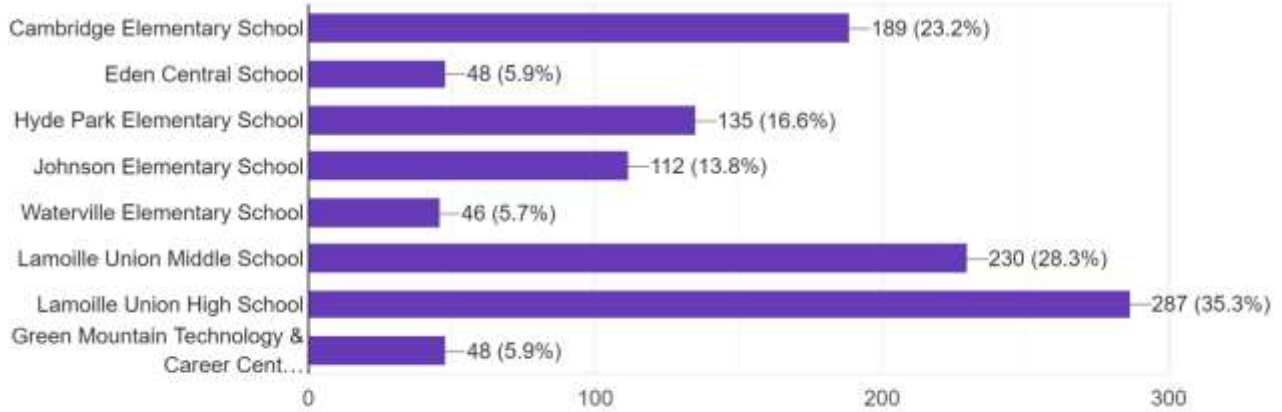


LNSU Reopening Schools Survey for Parents, July 2020, Broad View Results

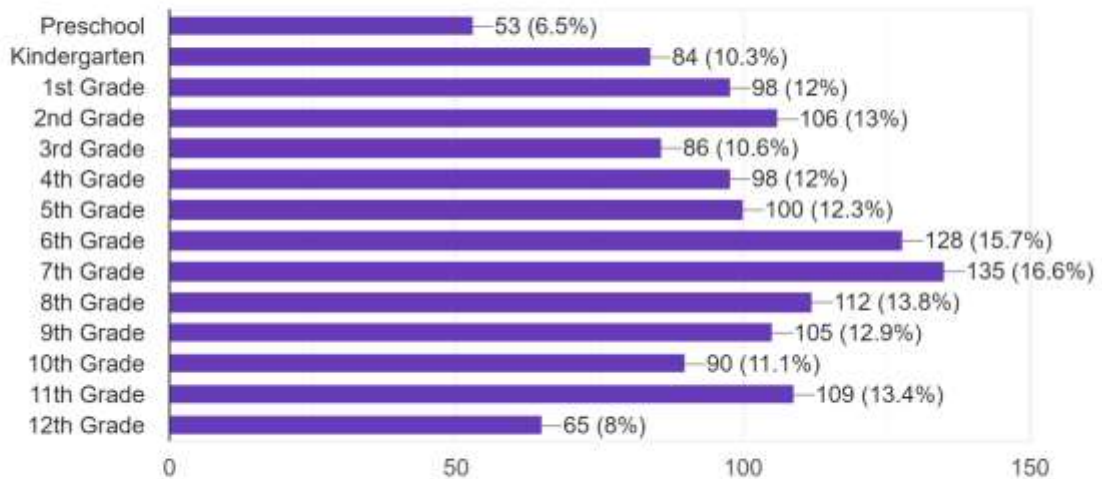
What school(s) will your student(s) be attending next year? Check all that apply.

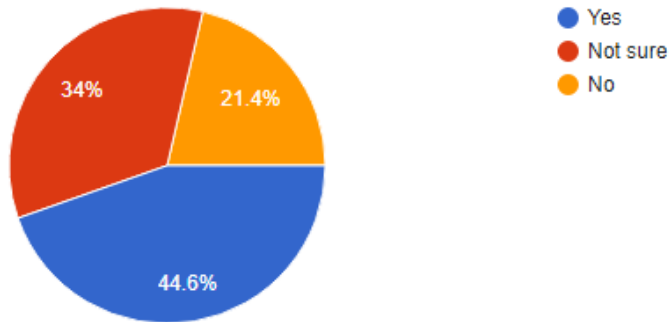
What grade(s) will your student(s) attend next year? Check all that apply.

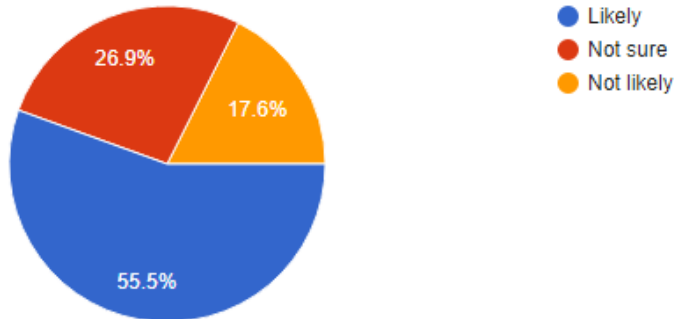
If all students and teachers are in school at the same time, are wearing masks, and other safety precautions are satisfied, would you consider sending your student(s) back to school five (5) days a week?

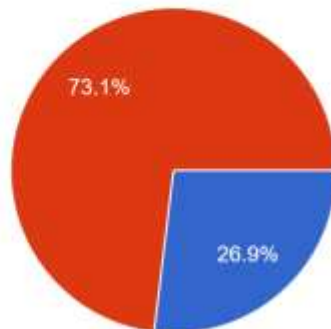

Given the opportunity, if we reopen schools in-person, would you prefer to maintain a remote learning experience for your student(s)?

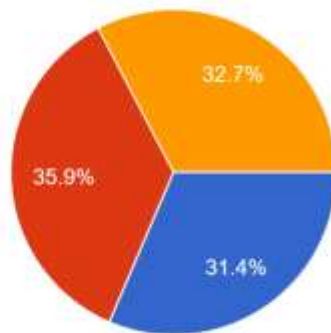

How likely are you to send your student(s) to school if we use Schedule 1 (AM/PM) this fall?

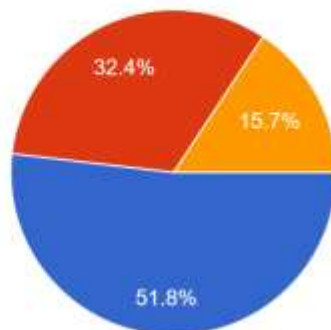

How likely are you to send your student(s) to school if we use Schedule 2 (Alternating Days) this fall?

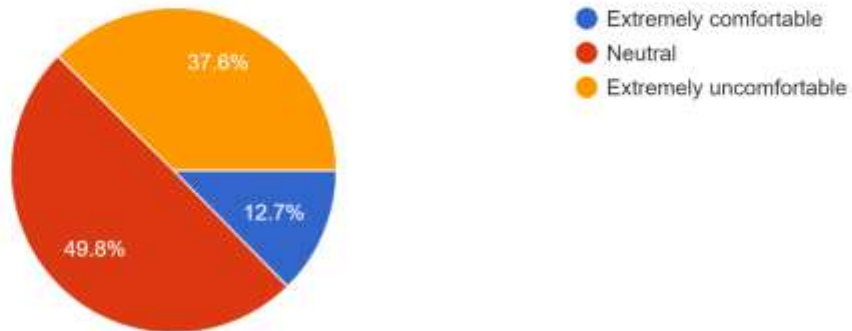

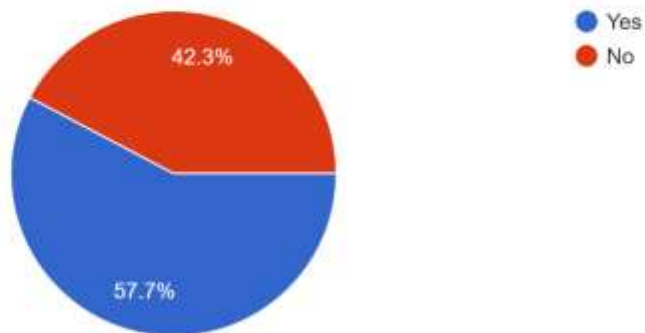
Knowing that physical distancing may not be possible on a school bus, how comfortable would you be with your student(s) riding the bus?

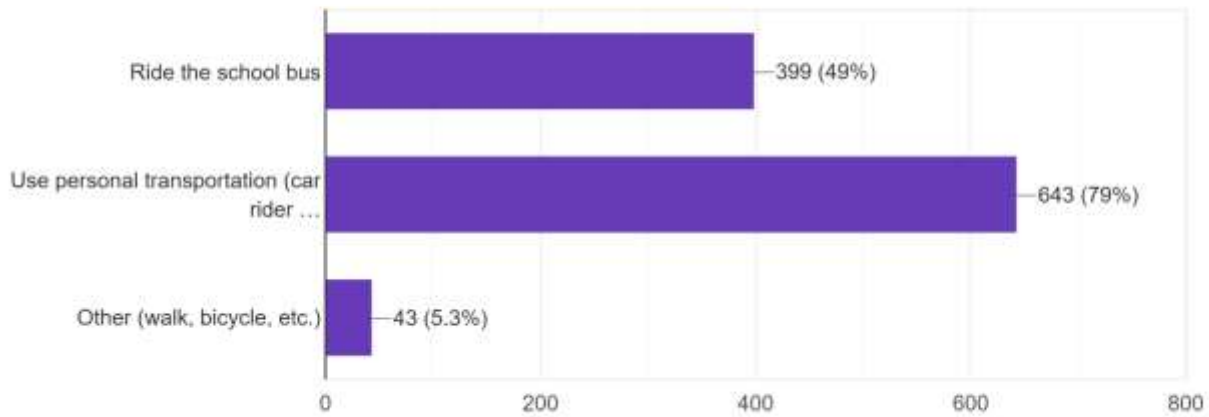
If my student(s) ride the bus, there is an adult who can supervise my student(s) at the bus stop until they are screened and allowed to board the bus?

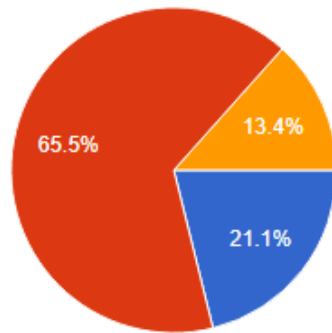
If students are in school five (5) days a week until the end of the school day, will you require afterschool care?

If we return to school in August in any of the previously mentioned hybrid models, or other models to be determined, would this present a childcare issue for you on the days or times when your child was not in school?

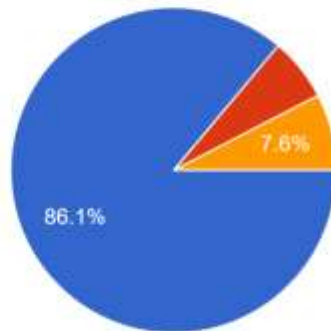
