Budget - Sherry present the budget. Budget notables:

*Offsetting increases in salaries and health benefits with cuts in nearly every line item available and controllable.

*Taking advantage of attrition by cutting one academic position and moving the teacher to the Special Needs Coordinator position, vacant through retirement.

*Academic program will reorganize with graduation-required proficiencies in focus to keep students on track for graduation, career and post-secondary education.

*Keeping in mind possible upcoming legislation regarding skilled labor force training and Career and Technical Education funding systems.

*Beginning a team approach to helping sending schools with Personalize Learning Plans.
